Date: Tuesday, February 2nd, 5:00pm (Japan Standard Time)

Abstract: Join Zenryu Owatari to learn about his unique journey into a monk's life. He will share the story of how and why he became a monastic monk in America, to his current path as an organic farmer in Kyoto. Topics to be covered will include Zen Buddhist philosophy and teachings, a brief history of Buddhism in Japan, and how Zen Buddhism has influenced Japanese culture and society. Zenryu will also share how he incorporates Zen Buddhist teachings into his everyday life practice.



Biography: Zenryu Owatari was born in Japan but moved to Los Angeles as a young adult to live a monastic life at his Zen-Buddhist Temple for over 20 years. He helped build the temple and train disciples in the teachings of Zazen Meditation, Hatha Yoga, Hindu teachings, and Zen Buddhism. He was also the "Tenzo Osho", the head chef of the temple with a passion for traditional vegan Japanese temple cuisine called, "Shojin Ryori".
