

# 留学生宿舎で新型コロナウイルス感染が疑われる場合等の対応フロー

発熱等の風邪  
症状がある

- ・息苦しさ（呼吸困難）、強いだるさ（倦怠感）、高熱等の強い症状のいずれかがある場合
- ・重症化しやすい者（※）で、発熱や咳などの比較的軽い風邪の症状がある場合  
（※）糖尿病、心不全、呼吸器疾患（慢性閉塞性肺疾患など）等の基礎疾患がある者や透析を受けている者、免疫抑制剤や抗がん剤等を用いている者
- ・上記以外の者で発熱や咳など比較的軽い風邪の症状が4日以上続く場合  
（症状には個人差があるため、強い症状と思う場合にはすぐにかかりつけ医あるいは受診相談センターに相談すること。解熱剤などを飲み続けなければならない場合も同様。）

If you have cold symptoms such as a fever, etc.

- In the case of any strong symptoms such as difficulty breathing, strong sense of fatigue, high fever, etc.
- In the case of persons whose symptoms may easily become severe\*, relatively mild cold symptoms such as a fever, cough, etc.  
 \*Persons with fundamental illnesses such as diabetes, heart disorders, respiratory illnesses (such as COPD), persons undergoing dialysis treatment, or persons taking immunosuppressants, anticancer medicines, etc.
- Persons other than the above in the case that relatively mild cold symptoms such as a fever, cough, etc. persist for 4 or more days  
 (As there are individual differences in symptoms, if you think you have strong symptoms, immediately consult your regular doctor or the COVID-19 Diagnosis Consultation Center. This also applies in the case that you need to continually take fever-reducing medicines or other medicines.)

Do not go to the campus but contact the university section to which you are affiliated\*1 and the dormitory manager by e-mail or telephone.

\* Class professor, advising professor, club activity advising professor, person in charge of student affairs at the faculty you are affiliated to

• Stay in your own room.  
 • Consult with your regular doctor or the COVID-19 Diagnosis Consultation Center by telephone, make an appointment, and then, wearing a mask, undergo a medical examination at the designated medical institution.

Undergo PCR Test  
 \*Even if you are not instructed to do so by the public health center, undergo a PCR test in the case that Okayama University judges that it is necessary.

Positive

Move to a hotel or medical institution as instructed by the public health center.

Negative

Return to your own room

In the case that there is a possibility that you have been in (close) contact with an infected person:  
 The residents of International Student Shared House move to a hotel arranged by the university, and the residents of other dormitories stay in their own room.  
 \*When a person with fever or other symptoms (not yet confirmed as COVID) appears in the same unit of International Student Shared House, all residents except those with fever will temporarily stay at International House.

Person unwell tests positive

The public health center or positive person identifies the person who has been in close contact.

Close contacts move to a hotel arranged by the university.

Close contacts undergo PCR Test  
 \*Even if the person is not instructed to do so by the public health center, undergo a PCR test in the case that Okayama University judges that it is necessary.

Person unwell tests negative

Return to your own room

Move to a hotel or medical institution as instructed by the public health center.

Report the diagnosis and test result by e-mail or telephone each time to the university section to which you are affiliated and the dormitory manager.
