English Language and Culture

Our English Language and Culture course will provide you with a deeper understanding of British culture while also improving your English language skills.

This course provides you with the opportunity to broaden your cultural horizons and raise your international awareness and sensitivity to UK culture. You will learn about various aspects of British culture and will be asked to reflect and discuss the potential reasons behind cultural similarities and differences. Sessions will also focus on language skills including vocabulary learning and pronunciation skills. You will also need to complete a weekly reflective journal. The journal task is a great way for you to reflect deeply on your cultural observations, to engage in research on chosen topics and to improve your written communication skills.

We will bring York to life for you through our virtual tours and through matching you with a local host family who you will meet for weekly chats. Your family will help answer any questions you have about British culture and assist you with your cultural project.

All aspects of the course are tied together through a cultural project. This small scale research project will provide you with the opportunity to learn more about one cultural topic in depth. The project will involve you creating a website, and conducting secondary research. At the end of the component, you will present your findings in a group online presentation.

Course aims

- To broaden your cultural horizons and raise your international awareness and sensitivity to UK culture;
- To give you a better understanding of the cultural differences between your home country and the UK;
- To develop your language skills through a communicative and functional language-based approach;
- To provide you with the experience of conducting a small scale research project.
