1. Minimum coursework required: 10 hours per week (5 credits)
  2. The courses listed in the EPOK Course Catalogue are offered in English.

  3. EPOK students can take the courses listed in the EPOK Course Catalogue.
    - As indicated in the list, some courses have prerequisite and require an approval from the instructor for enrollment. If interested in taking them, you need to contact the instructor via email well in advance before the semester begins. Remember to copy the email to your EPOK academic advisor.
    - Some faculty courses which are not listed on the EPOK course catalogue may be available to EPOK students under certain conditions including Japanese language proficiency. Read the syllabus well especially the “Target students” and “Open to other faculties” section as well as other requisites. If you wish to take the applicable course, contact the EPOK academic advisor well in advance to see if you are eligible and permitted to register in the course.

  4. Complete the EPOK Registration Memo and submit it to the EPOK academic advisor before /at the Advising Interview for approval.
  5. You can register the approved courses online for yourself on the Academic Affairs System\*\*
  6. To drop classes, report to the EPOK academic advisor with the Course Drop Report when making a change by yourself online Academic Affairs System (TBA).\*
    - \*After the period, you are not allowed to change your classes.
  7. Regarding the Japanese Language Course, you need to refer to the Japanese Course Catalogue.(See to About Japanese Language Course on the page 47~)
  8. At the end of your exchange period, “Certificate of Attendance (EPOK)” will be issued to those who completed the semester(s) with the grade transcript.  
“EPOK Certificate of Study Japan” can be obtained additionally if you pursue to fulfill its requirements.

- If you require special consideration and support in the classes, please provide the relevant medical certification to the EPOK academic advisor.

## ● EPOK Certificate (of Study Japan)

In order to obtain EPOK Certificate of Study Japan, students must complete the program under the certificate requisite as following:

- Students must earn 15 or more credits per semester (1&2 semester/ 3&4 semester) including:
- EPOK Research Project (I and II) < 2 credits>
  - EPOK Recommended Courses or/and Others: <2 credit or more>
  - Japanese Language Courses < 4 credit or more >
- Additional 7 credits should be taken either from EPOK elective or Japanese language or others.

- A full-year student who pursue a certificate “EPOK Certificate (1-Year)” must fulfil the requirement in both semesters (including minimum 15-credit) except for EPOK Research Project of 2-credit.
- A full-year student who fulfills the requirement only in either semester should receive “EPOK Certificate (6-Month).”

# Overview of the Academic Affairs System



The Academic Affairs System is designed to support various procedures that are vital to your campus life (i.e. academic affairs) such as registering courses, viewing academic records, and issuing certificates. An Okayama University ID (hereafter Okadai ID) is required to use the system. (The Center for Information Technology and Management will assign each student with an ID at the time of admission.)

- \* An Okadai ID is required to access various information services on campus. Please manage your ID and password properly. (Do not share them with anyone else.)
- \* Automatic certificate issuing machines are installed at the following locations:  
Tsushima Campus: the Building for General Education (two machines), Peach Union (one).  
Shikata Campus: on the 1st floor of the Administration building (one).

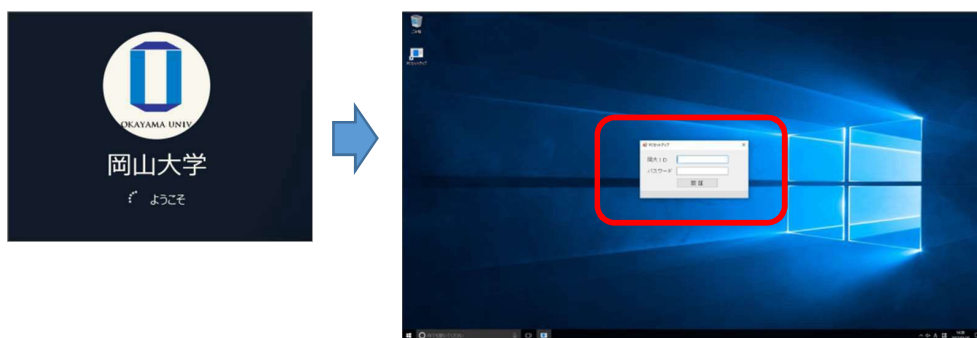

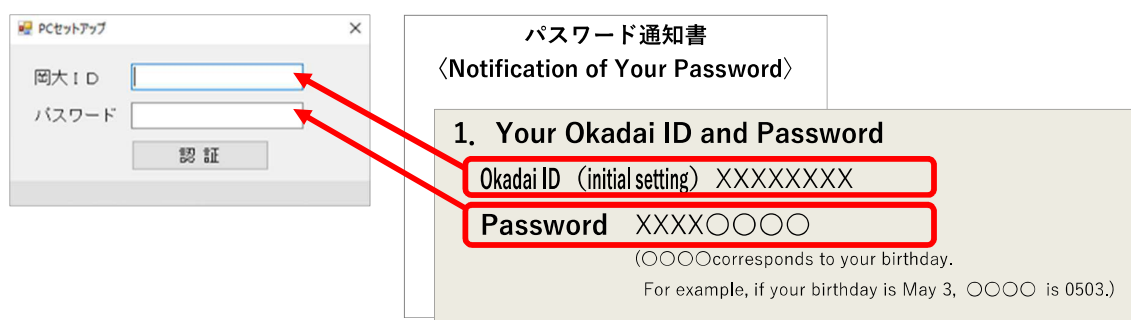


## 1. Log in to a school computer

- 1 Turn on the PC. After a while, the desktop screen will appear. The “PC セットアップ (PC setup)” window as below pops up automatically.



- 2 Enter your Okadai ID and password (indicated in the “パスワード通知書 [Notification of Your Password]”) in the boxes of the popup window, and click the **認証** (Confirm) button.

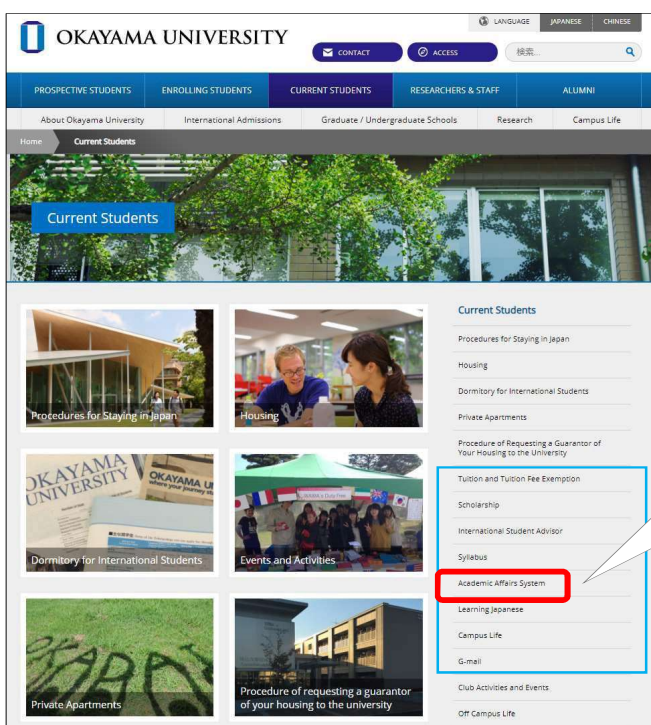

- 1 Open the web browser and access the Okayama University official website. Click on “Current students”, which is displayed in the top menu.

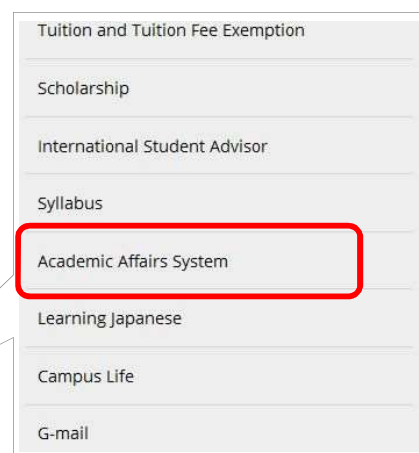

# Registering for courses online

The registration process is divided into two periods; namely the Course Registration Period, where you can add and drop courses, and the Course Deletable Period, where you can only drop courses. Details regarding the duration of each period will be announced separately by each faculty and may differ slightly. Additionally, there may be some courses that students are not able to register for online by themselves, so please pay close attention to the notices displayed on the Academic Affairs System.

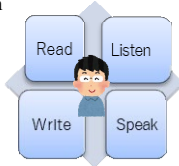


**Q : What is the Okayama University Japanese Language Course like?**

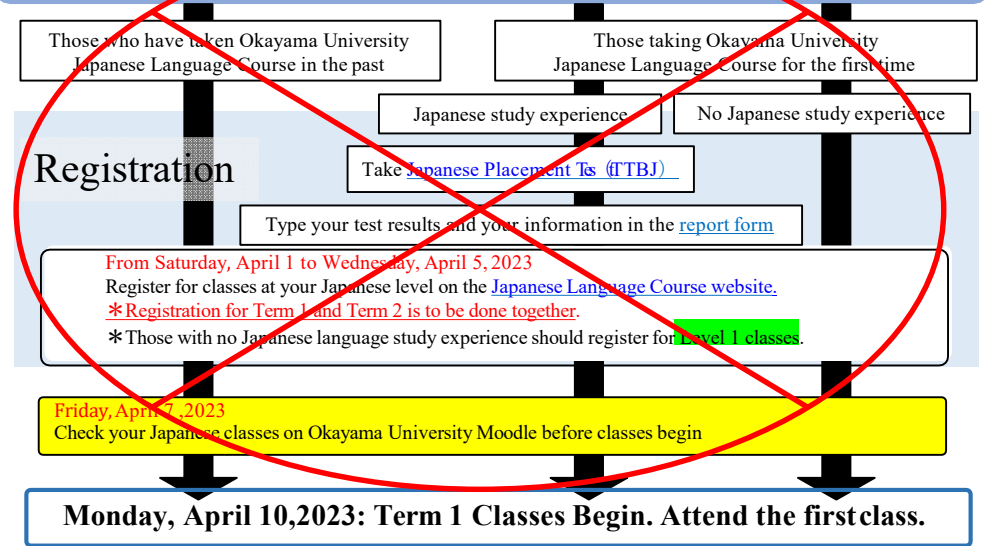

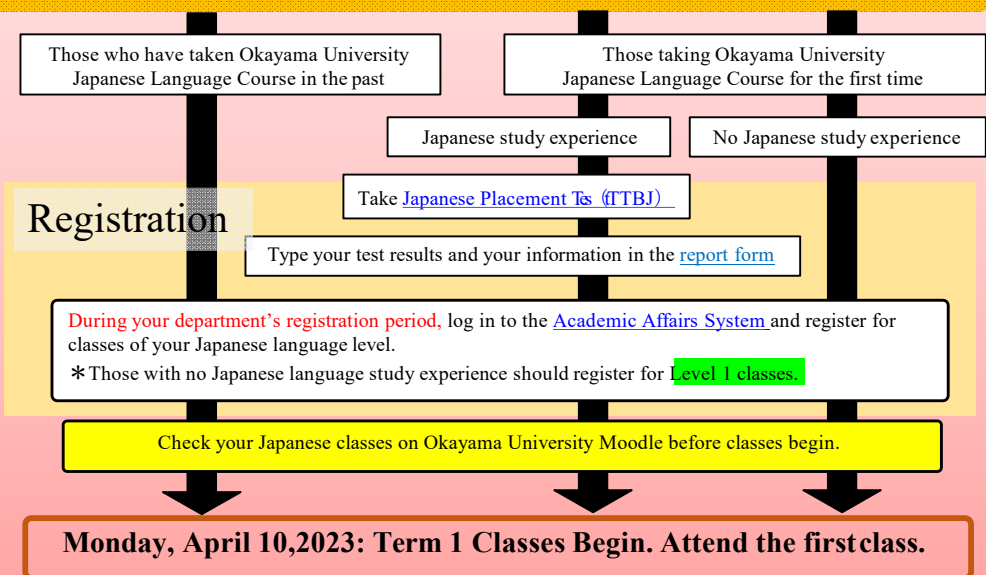

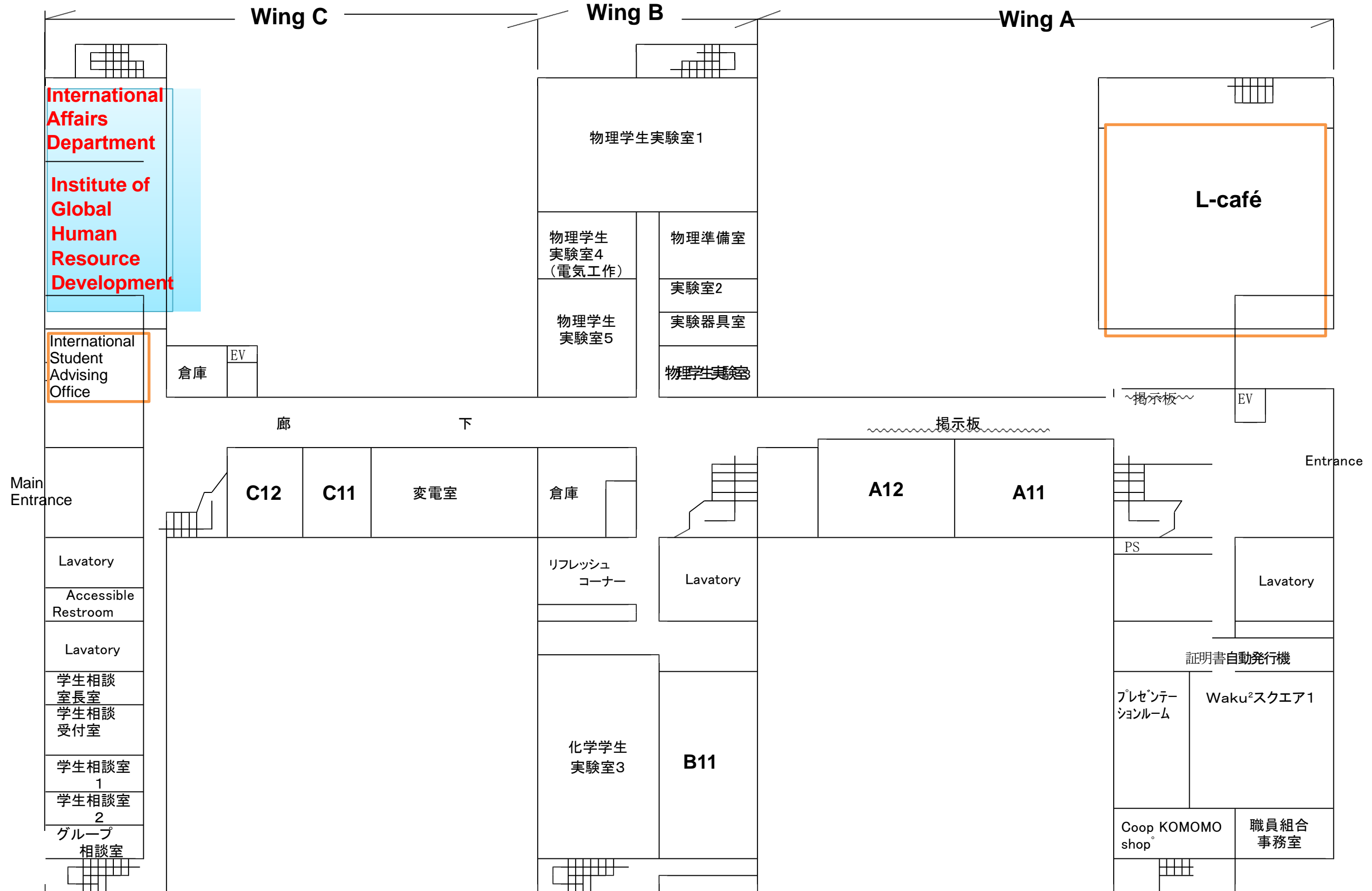

Building for General Education 1F, (Wing A, Wing B, Wing C)



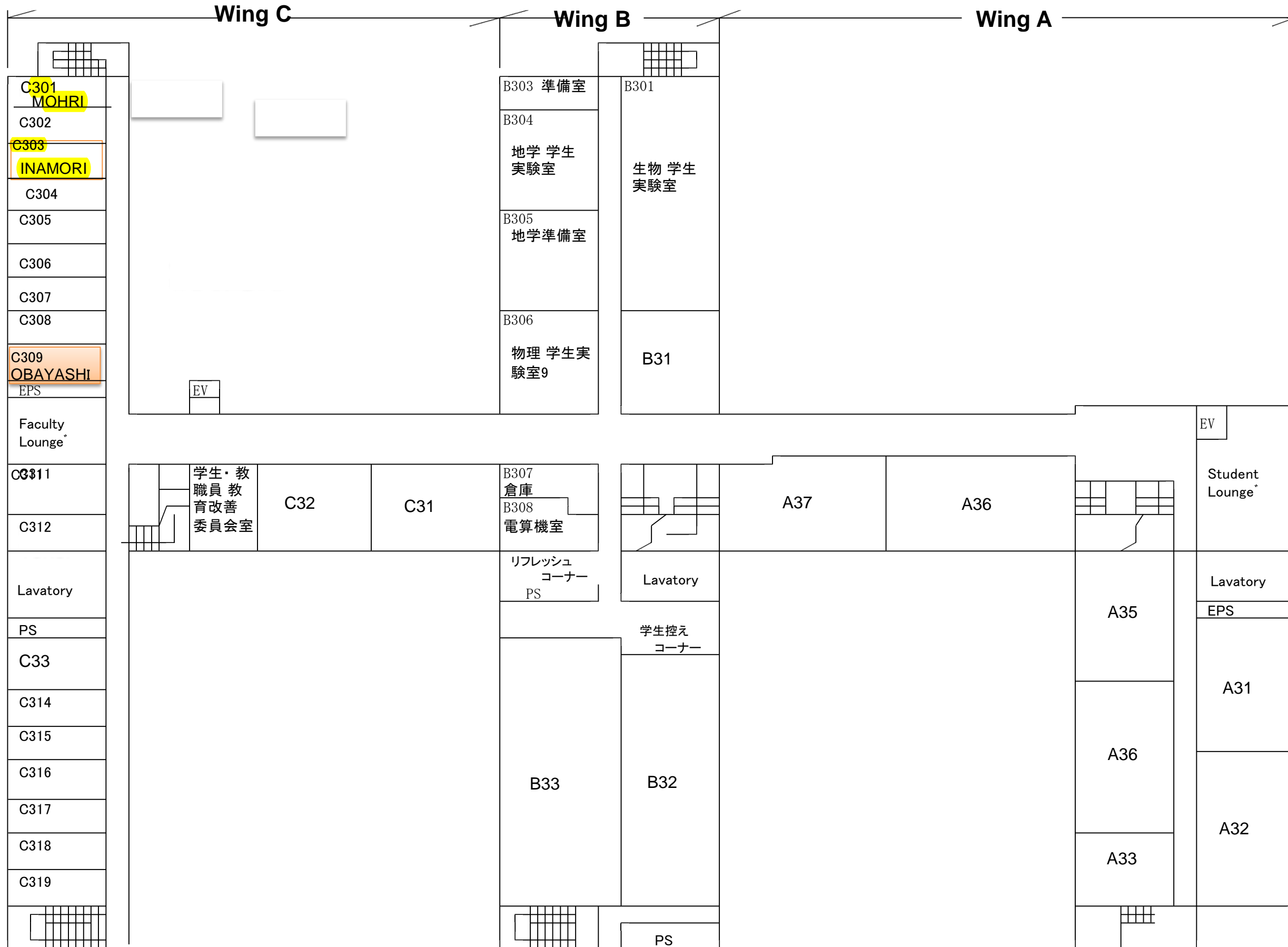

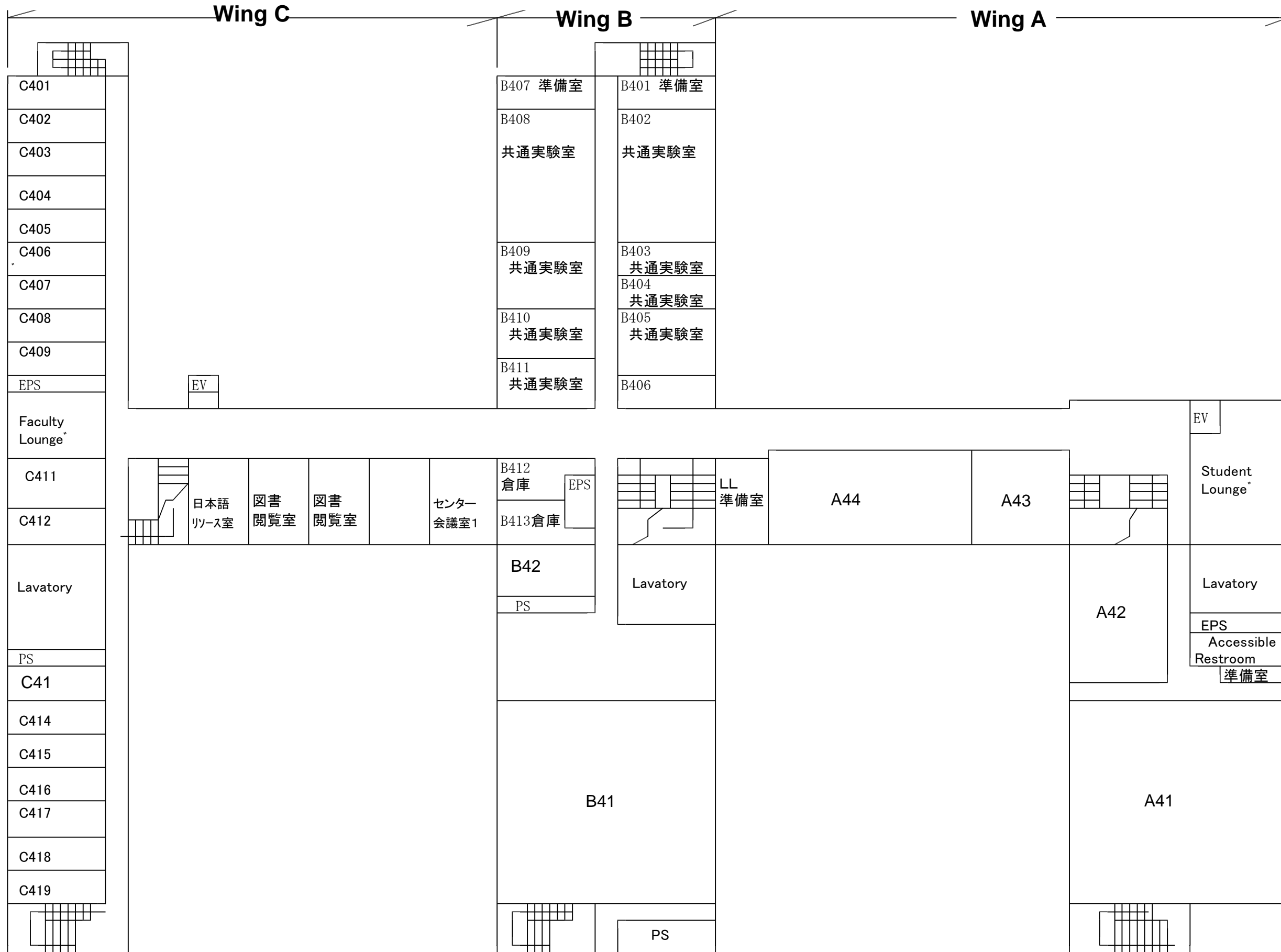

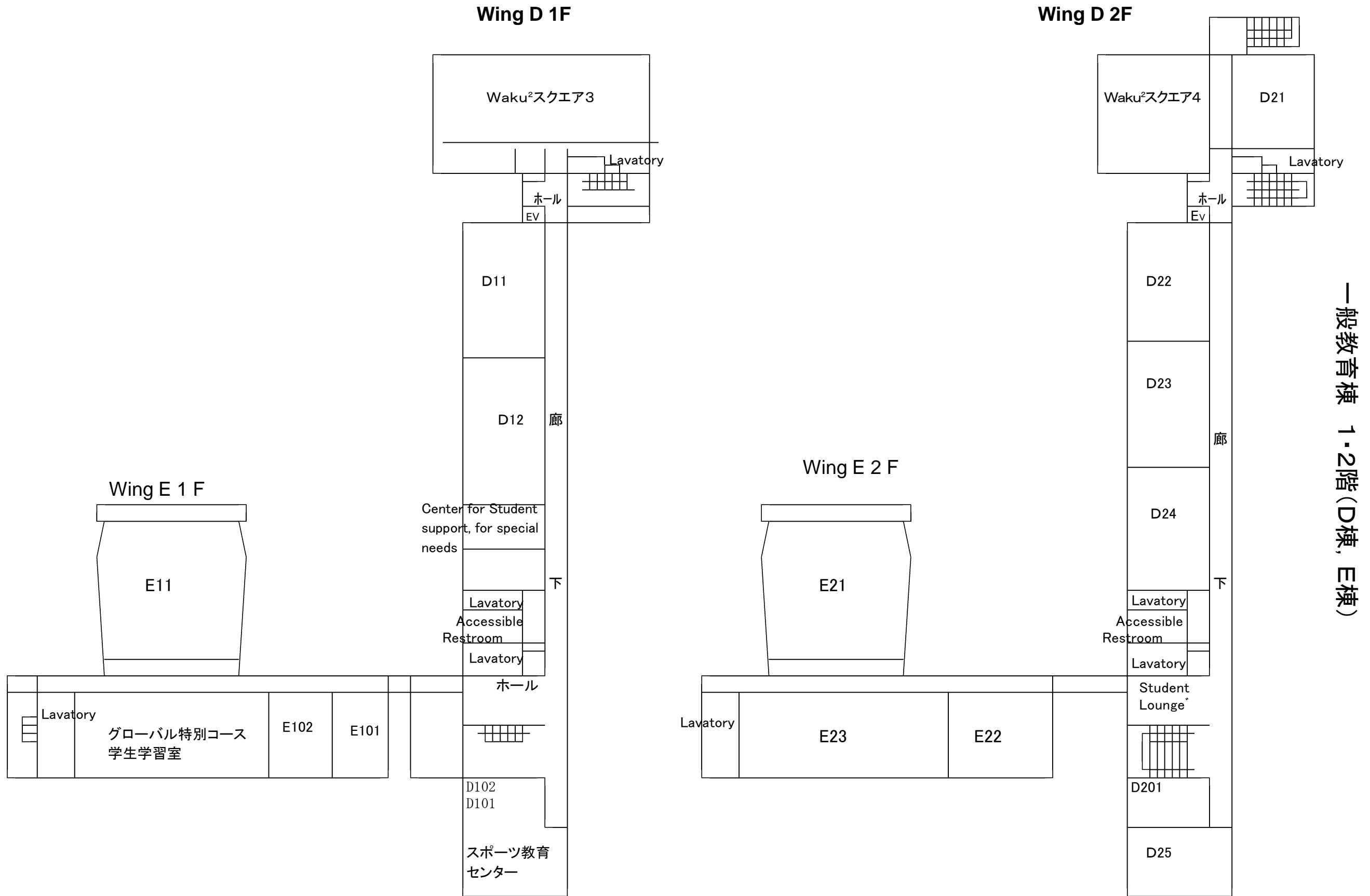

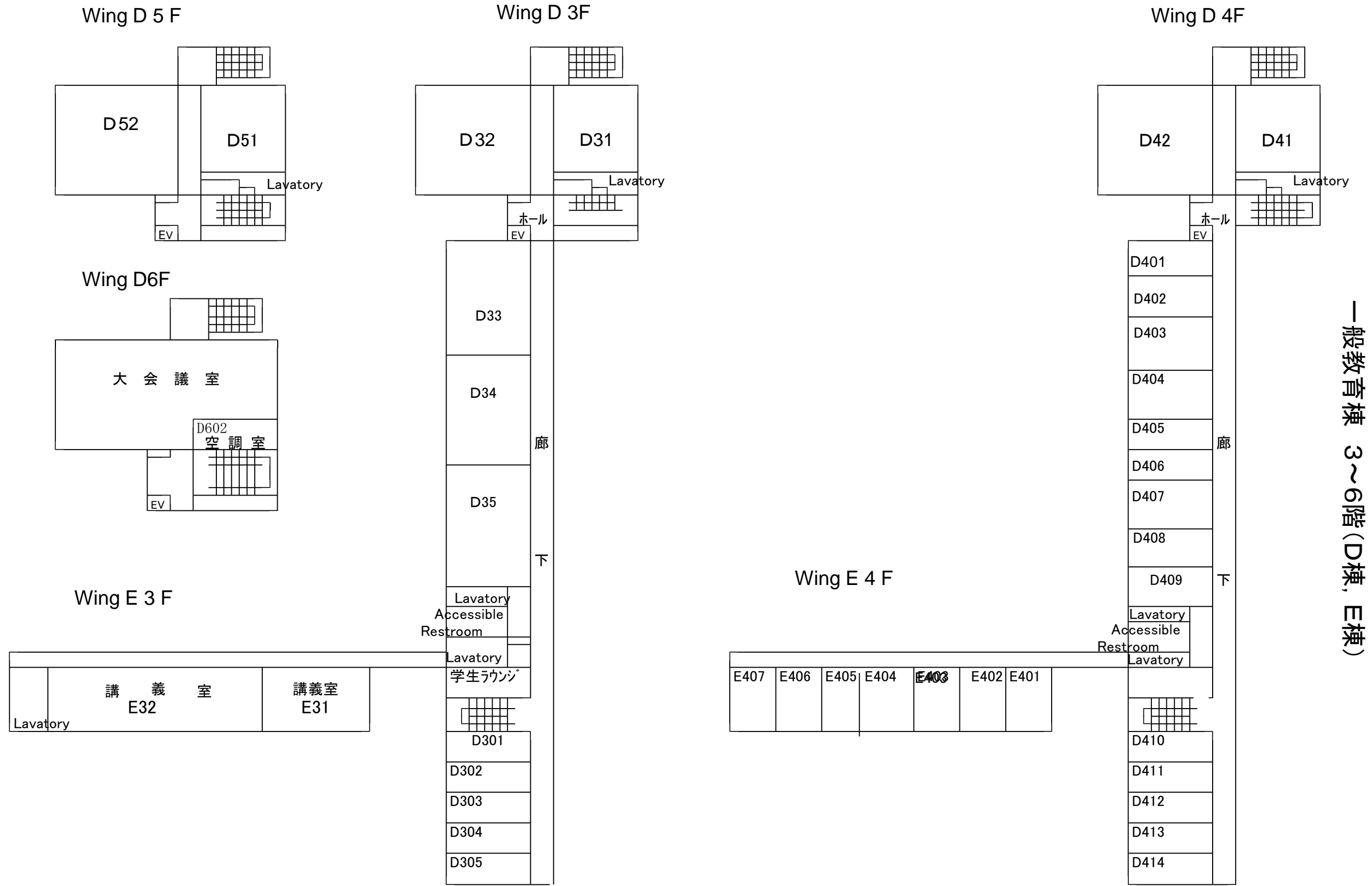
