

**AY2023 Monbukagakusho Honors Scholarship  
for Privately Financed International Students (Gakushu-Shoureihi)  
Application Requirements**

◆ **Who Can Apply:**

Those whose status of residence is “student” and satisfy all of the following:

- Those who came to Japan in AY2015 or later and are enrolled as a regular student (undergraduate/graduate student) at Okayama University.
- Those whose nationality is Indonesia, Cambodia, Singapore, Thailand, the Philippines, Brunei, Vietnam, Malaysia, Myanmar or Laos.

◆ **Eligibility Requirements:**

Applicants must be Privately Financed International Students (Those who are not a recipient of the Japanese Government (Monbukagakusho: MEXT) scholarship or Interexchange Association Japan (IAJ), nor a sponsored student of a foreign government.) enrolled at Okayama University, possess outstanding academic record, have demonstrate personal integrity, have difficulty in studying for financial reasons, and meet all of the following requirements:

- a) Applicants have a Grade Point Average of 2.3 or higher in the previous academic year based on the following calculation.

Calculation of Grade Point Average (3-level scale):

$$\{( \text{Number of credits with A and A+ grade} \times 3 ) + ( \text{Number of credits with B grade} \times 2 ) + ( \text{Number of credits with C grade} \times 1 ) + ( \text{Number of credits with F grade} \times 0 )\} / \text{total number of registered credits}$$

- b) Applicants meet the required language proficiency level specified in the “Requirements for Language Proficiency under the Monbukagakusho Honors Scholarship for Privately-Financed International Students”.
- c) Applicants agree to cooperate in the career path survey conducted by JASSO through the University after completion of the scholarship period.
- d) Average monthly allowance (excluding enrollment and tuition fees, etc.) received by the applicant do not exceed 90,000 yen.
- e) Annual income of a financial supporter in Japan must be less than 5 million yen (if an applicant has any supporter in Japan).
- f) Applicants must not be receiving or are not nominated as a candidate for any scholarship that cannot be combined with other scholarships.

◆ **Number of Recipients: 6 new recipients (planned)**

◆ **Amount of Scholarship: 48,000 yen (Monthly stipend)**

◆ **Scholarship period: April 2023 to March 2024**

◆ **Application Period:** **By Thursday, 20 April 2023, 5 p.m.**

◆ **Where to Apply:**

Apply on Okayama University moodle from the website of the Institute of Global Human Resource Development.

- 1) Pre-register for the application with “the Pre-Registration Form for Scholarship Application“ on Okayama University moodle.
- 2) Apply for scholarships by the deadline with the application form on Okayama University moodle.

- 1) By Friday 28 April, submit a Pledge to the International Affairs Department and sign the April enrollment confirmation.**
- 2) By Wednesday 10 May, submit the following application documents to the International Affairs Department.**

◆ **Application Documents**

- a) Scholarship Policy (prescribed form)
- b) Supplemental information for candidates selection of scholarships 2023 (prescribed form)
- c) Language proficiency requirements (form G)
- d) Copy of score certificate or copy of the document certifying that you meet the language proficiency requirements (if an applicant selected category 1 ~ 6 for either Japanese or English on the form G under c))
- e) Copy of the residence card (both sides)
- f) Copy of the first page with your name and account number of Japan Post Bank passbook
