 - 1. Minimum coursework required: 10 hours per week (5 credits)
 - 2. The courses listed in the EPOK Course Catalogue are offered in English. To check the Syllabi of the courses, visit the link below: https://kyomu.adm.okayama-u.ac.jp/Portal/Public/Syllabus/SearchMain.aspx
 - 3. EPOK students can take the courses listed in the EPOK Course Catalogue.
 - ➤ As indicated in the list, some courses have prerequisite and require an approval from the instructor for enrollment. If interested in taking them, you need to contact the instructor via email well in advance before the semester begins. Remember to copy the email to your EPOK academic advisor.
 - Some faculty courses which are not listed on the EPOK course catalogue may be available to EPOK students under certain conditions including Japanese language proficiency. Read the syllabus well especially the "Target students" and "Open to other faculties" section as well as other requisites. If you wish to take the applicable course, contact the EPOK academic advisor well in advance to see if you are eligible and permitted to register in the course.

- 8. At the end of your exchange period, "Certificate of Attendance (EPOK)" will be issued to those who completed the semester(s) with the grade transcript. "EPOK Certificate of Study Japan" can be obtained additionally if you pursue to fulfill its

In order to obtain EPOK Certificate of Study Japan, students must complete the program under the certificate requisite as following:

Students must earn 15 or more credits per semester (1&2 semester/ 3&4 semester)

including: EPOK Research Project < 2 credits>

EPOK Recommended Courses or/and Others: <2 credit or more>

Japanese Language Courses < 4 credit or more >

Additional 7 credits should be taken either from EPOK elective or Japanese language or others.

- ➤ A full-year student who pursue a certificate "EPOK Certificate (1-Year)" must fulfill the requirement in both semesters (including minimum 15-credit) except for EPOK Research Project of 2-credit.
- ➤ A full-year student who fulfills the requirement only in either semester should receive "EPOK Certificate (6-Month)."

Registering for courses online




The registration process is divided into two periods; namely the Course Registration Period, where you can add and drop courses, and the Course Deletable Period, where you can only drop courses. Details regarding the duration of each period will be announced separately by each faculty and may differ slightly. Additionally, there may be some courses that students are not able to register for online by themselves, so please pay close attention to the notices displayed on the Academic Affairs System.



3. How to drop a course


In order to drop a course, click the "delete" button displayed on the timetable.





Okayama University Moodle system







Gmail

Integrated Classes

The integrated classes meet four days a week. Students learn the four skills (reading, writing, listening and speaking) in an integrated manner through

grammar and vocabulary. Students must attend Classes four times a week.



Skill-based and Topic-based Classes

The skill-based and topic-based classes meet 1-2 days a week. Students can select classes according to their interests.

- * You can only take Japanese subjects at your level.
