

TERMS OF REFERENCE ASEAN VOLUNTARY PROGRAMME WORLD EXPO 2025 OSAKA

A. BACKGROUND

The World Expo

World Expos are a global gathering of nations dedicated to finding solutions to pressing challenges by offering a journey inside a universal theme through engaging and immersive activities. The World Expo 2025 will take place in Osaka, Japan, from 13 April to 13 October 2025. It adopted the theme of "Designing Future Societies for Our Lives" and aims to build partnerships and inspire ideas that will forge the world of tomorrow through three sub-themes: Saving Lives, Empowering Lives and Connecting Lives. ASEAN Pavilion

At the invitation of the Japan government, the ASEAN Secretariat (ASEC) will take part in this World Expo 2025 Osaka by managing the ASEAN Pavilion at the Shared Pavilion Unit B of the Empowering Zone. The 72 m² booth will showcase stories about ASEAN's success and how ASEAN cooperation benefits its citizens and the world beyond.

The ASEAN Pavilion will highlight the theme "Building Bridges".

- The theme is a portrayal of ASEAN's history and what it aims to do through its cooperation mechanisms, initiatives, and associated organs such as the ASEAN Centres and Foundations.
- "Building Bridges" is both an ambition and a strategy that will propel ASEAN into a future society where communities create connections instead of divisions. It will be an all-encompassing phrase for a regional organisation that brings together the Member States under ASEAN's Post-2025 Vision.

B. ASEAN VOLUNTARY PROGRAMME AT THE WORLD EXPO 2025 OSAKA

In the spirit of inclusivity, the ASEC plans to engage **volunteers** in embodying and sharing the ASEAN story to the ASEAN Pavilion's visitors. The ASEAN Voluntary Programme at World Expo 2025 Osaka aims to offer the volunteers the following opportunities:

- Experience working on a mega event;
- Contribute their skills and talents as active participants in World Expo 2025
 Osaka;
- Gain exposure to real life work and enhance skills for future employability;
- Learn about ASEAN stories and be trained to articulate them verbally;
- Build a network within the ASEAN family;
- Gain new friends from the international community of volunteers and visitors at the World Expo 2025 Osaka; and
- Learn about progress and innovations in ASEAN through the exhibits/features in ASEAN Member States pavilions/booths.

C. Duties & Responsibilities

In assisting the ASEC staff in managing the pavilion, the volunteers will undertake the following duties:

- Welcome guests to the ASEAN Pavilion, guide them through the presentation boards, and tell the ASEAN stories;
- Provide administrative support to the responsible staff within the ASEAN Pavilion:
- Liaise with World Expo 2025 Osaka personnel to support and manage the ASEAN pavilion as required;
- Provide support to ASEAN events at the Expo, such as ASEAN Day and ASEAN Presents;
- Undertake any other World Expo-related duties as assigned by the ASEC staff.

D. Requirements

To be eligible for the programme, the volunteers are strongly advised to meet the following requirements:

- Can be either Japanese citizens or any ASEAN nationals who are already residing in Japan;
- Ability to communicate in both English <u>and</u> Japanese (verbal and written);
- No age limitation;
- Be able to withstand at least 7 out of 180 days of Expo period, with ideally
 4 volunteers per day or 2 volunteers per shift;
- Applicants with availability for more than 7 days are welcome.

E. Benefits

The selected volunteers will be entitled to the following benefits:

- Recognized as ASEAN Secretariat Pavilion staff and their identity accreditation shall be facilitated accordingly;
- Accommodation option;
- A set of uniform;
- Certificate of appreciation upon submission of Programme Completion Report; and
- \$150 voluntary allowance upon the completion of a 7-day working period

F. Application & Timeline

Applicants are encouraged to apply as early as possible as applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis. Additional steps such as interviews and further assessments may be conducted to ensure the selection of the most suitable volunteers. Please note that only selected applicants will be contacted.
