Report on the status of activities other than those permitted under the status of residence (part-time work) is required!

- In April 2024, the Immigration Law was revised, making it mandatory for universities to properly manage the status of international students' status of residence and their compliance with activities other than those permitted under the current status of residence (part-time work) for all international students.
- From October 2024, Okayama University will require all international students to report the following items to Okayama University through ORRS(<u>O</u>kayama University <u>Residence Registration System</u>)*.
- Register your contact information in Japan (e-mail address, telephone number, address)
- 2 Upload an image(photo) of your residence card and enter the information on it
- 3 Whether or not you have permission to engage in activities other than those permitted under the current status of residence
- Whether or not Part-time job status
- 5 Registration of part-time job information
- 6 Report the number of hours you work part-time each month
