General Information

1. Minimum Course Load

Exchange students are required to enroll in a minimum workload of 10 class hours per week (equivalent to 5 credits).

2. Courses Offered in the EPOK Course Catalog

The courses listed in the EPOK Course Catalog are primarily conducted in English. Course syllabi may be accessed through the Academic Affairs System at the following link: <https://kyomu.adm.okayama-u.ac.jp/Portal/Public/Syllabus/SearchMain.aspx>

3. Course Enrollment and Eligibility

Exchange students are eligible to enroll in courses listed in the EPOK Course Catalog. Certain courses may:

- require fulfillment of prerequisite conditions;
- require prior approval from the course lecturer.

In such cases, prior communication with the course lecturer is required before the commencement of the semester. All correspondence must be copied to the EPOK Academic Advisor.

4. Enrollment in Courses Outside the EPOK Course Catalog

Under specific conditions, Exchange students may be permitted to enroll in faculty courses not listed in the EPOK Course Catalog. Enrollment in courses conducted in Japanese generally requires advanced Japanese language proficiency. In principle, proof of Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) Level N1 or equivalent proficiency is required. Careful review of the course syllabus, particularly the sections “Target Students” and “Open to Other Faculties,” is strongly recommended prior to requesting enrollment. Eligibility for such courses is determined in consultation with the EPOK Academic Advisor.

5. Japanese Language Courses

Japanese language courses are offered through the Japanese Language Program at Okayama University. For detailed information, please refer to Guide to Japanese Language Courses.

6. Registration Procedure

Detailed information regarding course registration procedures and the course registration schedule will be provided during the EPOK Guidance session. The registration timeline for Exchange students under the EPOK program differs from that of other faculties. All procedures must be completed in accordance with the instructions of the EPOK Academic Advisor and the EPOK Administrative Staff. Course registration is conducted through the following process:

- (1) Submission of the EPOK Course Registration Form via Moodle prior to the academic advising interview with the EPOK Academic Advisor;
- (2) Academic advising interview with the EPOK Academic Advisor;
- (3) Online course registration through the Academic Affairs System following approval.

Course withdrawal or modification requires prior consultation with the EPOK Academic Advisor and submission of the EPOK Course Change Form before changes are made in the Academic Affairs System. After the designated registration period, modifications are not permitted. Refer to the Academic Affairs System Overview on page 35.

7. Certification

Upon successful completion of the exchange period, Exchange students will receive:

- Certificate of Attendance (EPOK);
- Official Academic Transcript.

8. Academic Accommodations

Exchange students requiring academic accommodations are requested to submit appropriate medical documentation to the EPOK Administrative Staff in advance.

11. Additional Certificates and Activities

This section outlines optional distinctions and experiential opportunities available to Exchange students under the EPOK program. These opportunities are not compulsory components of the exchange program and are awarded or completed in addition to regular academic requirements.

11.1 EPOK Certificate of Study in Japan

General Statement

The EPOK Research Project is not a compulsory component of the EPOK exchange program at Okayama University. Participation is voluntary and intended for Exchange students who wish to undertake supervised individual research. Exchange students who successfully fulfil the certificate requirements may be awarded the EPOK Certificate of Study in Japan in addition to the Certificate of Attendance and the Official Academic Transcript.

Nature of the EPOK Research Project

The EPOK Research Project involves supervised individual research conducted under the guidance of an assigned lecturer. Students enrolled in this project are expected to:

- formulate a research topic;
- design appropriate research methodology;
- conduct independent investigation (including surveys, interviews, or fieldwork);
- manage their own research schedule;
- submit the required academic outputs.

Participation should be based on genuine academic interest and readiness to undertake independent research.

For full-year Exchange students, the 2-credit EPOK Research Project (Spring or Fall) may be completed in either the Spring or Fall semester.

Certificate Types

- Exchange students who fulfill the certificate requirements in the One-Semester Program will receive the **EPOK Certificate of Study in Japan (One-Semester Program)**;
- Exchange students who fulfill the certificate requirements in the Full-Year Program will receive the **EPOK Certificate of Study in Japan (Full-Year Program)**.

Exchange students who did not fulfil the certificate requirements will receive the standard Certificate of Attendance and the Official Academic Transcript only.

11.2 Global Citizen Certificate

Overview

The Okayama University Global Citizen Certificate is an optional distinction awarded to Exchange students who make significant contributions to campus internationalization. The certificate is granted in addition to the Certificate of Attendance and is not a mandatory component of the EPOK program. Further details regarding eligibility and procedures will be provided during the EPOK Guidance session.

Eligibility

To qualify for the certificate, Exchange students must accumulate a minimum of 10 points through approved internationalization activities.

Eligible Activities

All activities must be conducted during the enrollment period and approved by the EPOK Academic Advisor. Eligible activities may include:

- participation and presentations in intercultural exchange events;
- cultural or academic contributions (e.g., guest talks, language support);
- student-initiated projects promoting intercultural understanding.

11.3 Global Campus Internship

This supervised internship provides Exchange students with practical experience in study-abroad support and international exchange activities at Okayama University. Internship participation requires enrollment in the designated academic module titled “Global Campus Internship: Study-Abroad Support and Intercultural Collaboration.” Under the supervision of the EPOK Academic Advisor and relevant administrative staff, participants engage in structured internship activities for a minimum of two hours per week, totaling more than 30 hours throughout the term.

Internship responsibilities may include:

- assisting with study-abroad counselling and student support;
- supporting the planning and organization of intercultural exchange events;
- contributing to SNS communication and campus information management;
- collaborating with Japanese students and administrative staff.

Through active participation, Exchange students develop practical skills in intercultural communication, teamwork, and problem-solving, while gaining insight into the organizational culture of Japanese universities.

A : The Japanese Language course has seven levels from elementary to advanced. There are integrated classes and skills-based / topic-based classes in the Japanese Language Course. **You can only take Japanese subjects at your level.**

Integrated Classes

The integrated classes meet four days a week. Students learn the four skills (reading, writing, listening and speaking) in an integrated manner through grammar and vocabulary. Students must attend Classes four times a week.



Skill-based and Topic-based Classes

The skill-based and topic-based classes meet 1-2 days a week. Students can select classes according to their interests.



*** You cannot start to take Integrated Classes from Term 2.**

*** You can only take Japanese subjects at your level.**














